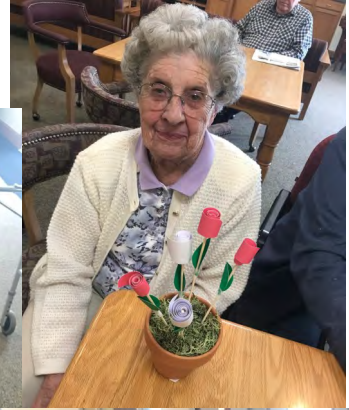

In the Good Old Days

In 1918 (100 years ago), the average annual income was \$1,115. The average cost of a new house was \$4,821. A loaf of bread was 10¢, and a gallon of milk was 55¢. You could purchase one dozen eggs for 37¢. Stamps were 3¢ each. A car cost \$365, and gas was 25¢ per gallon. According to the Consumer Price Index Calculator, \$1 in 1918 is equivalent to \$16.42 today.
